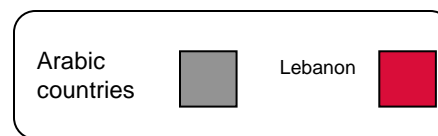

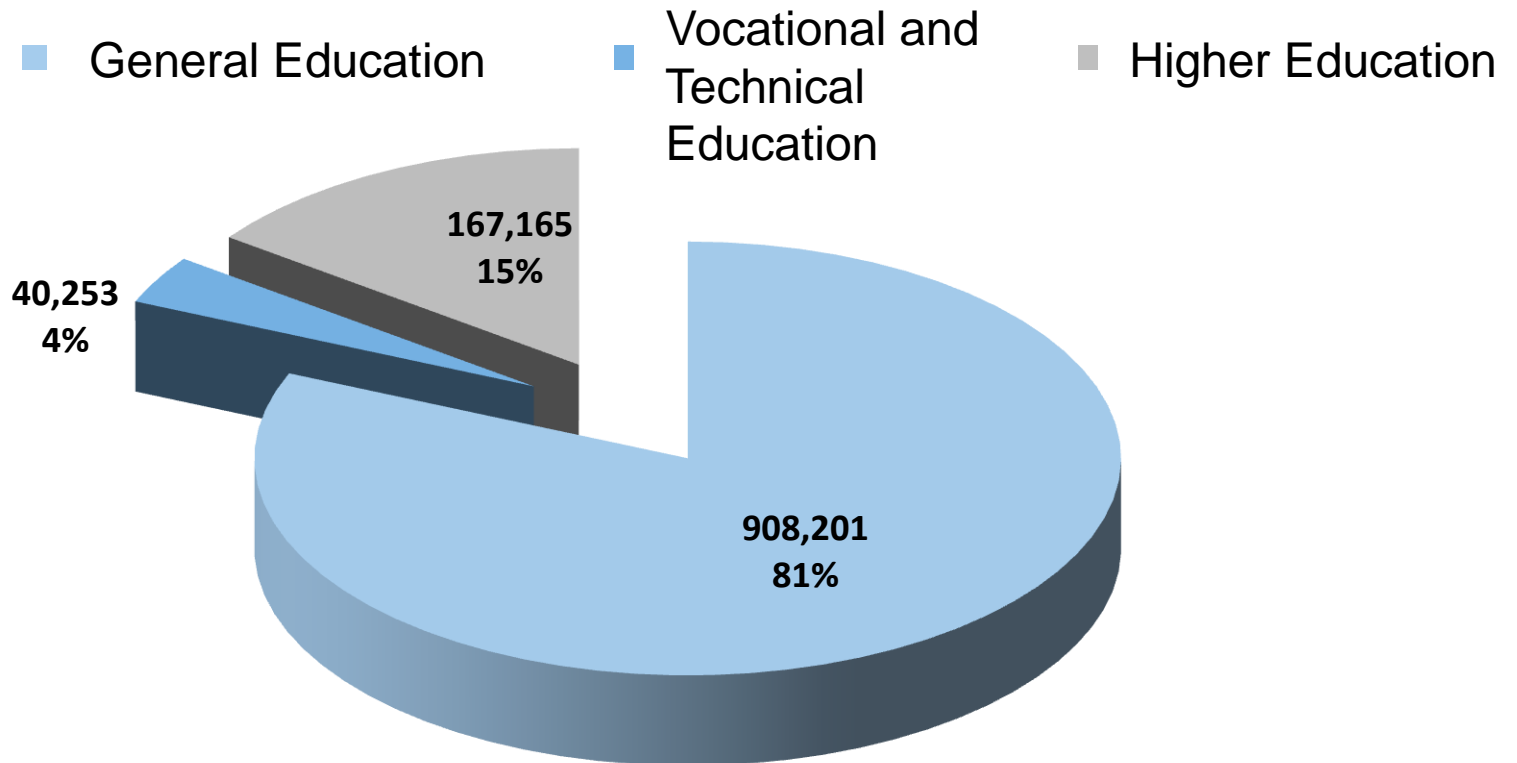

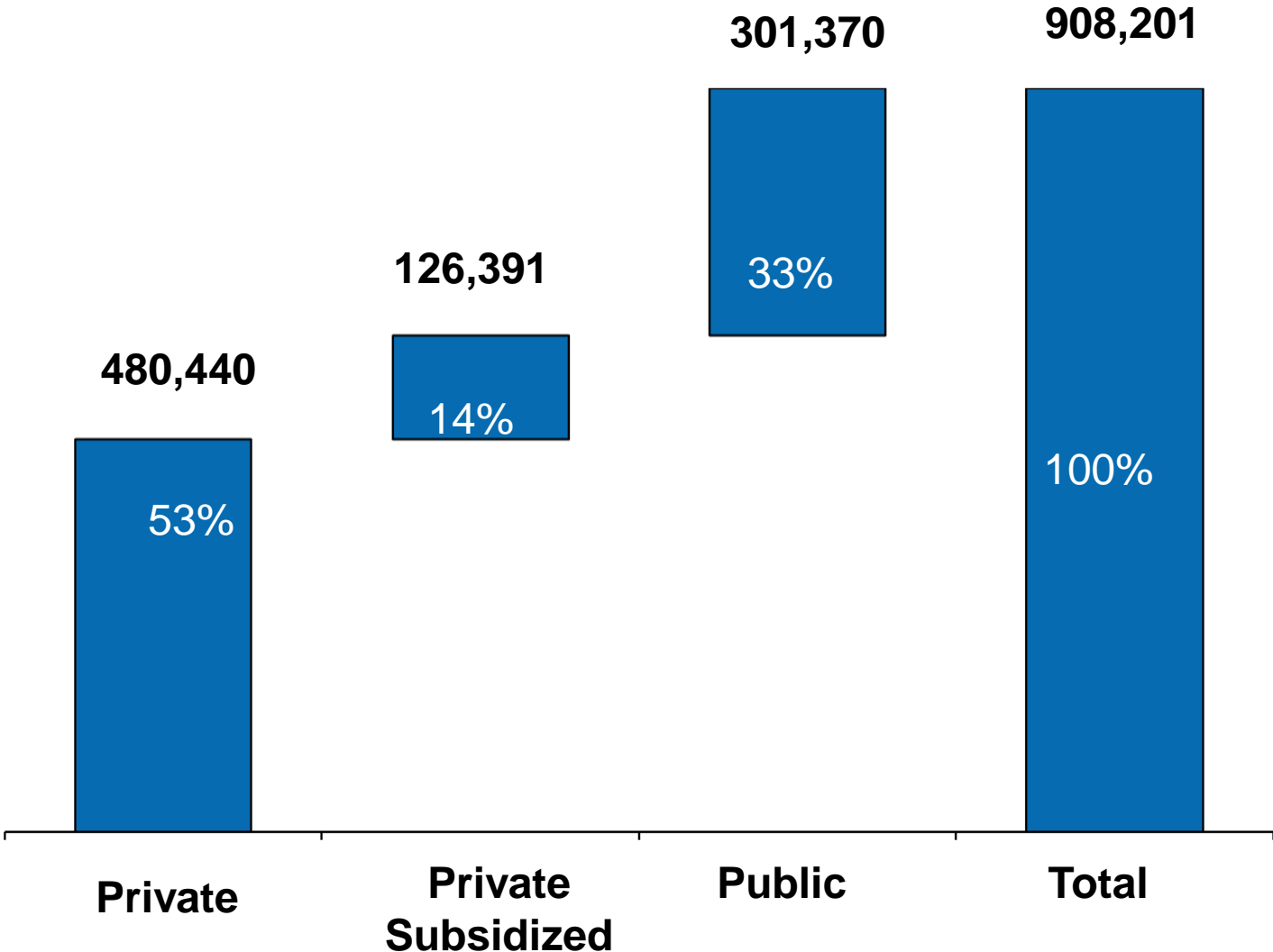

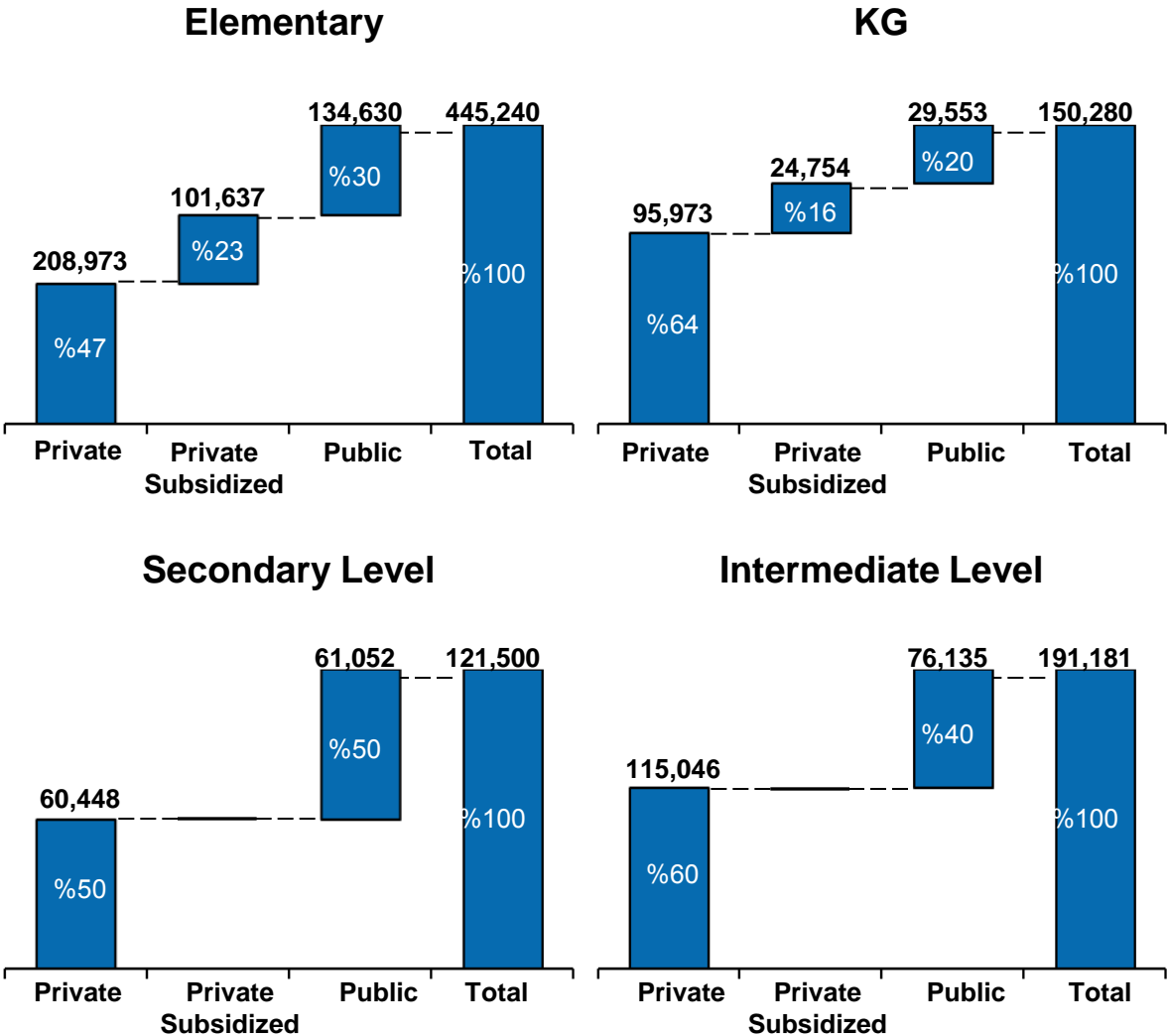
# Total Number of Students According to Education Sectors 2007-2008

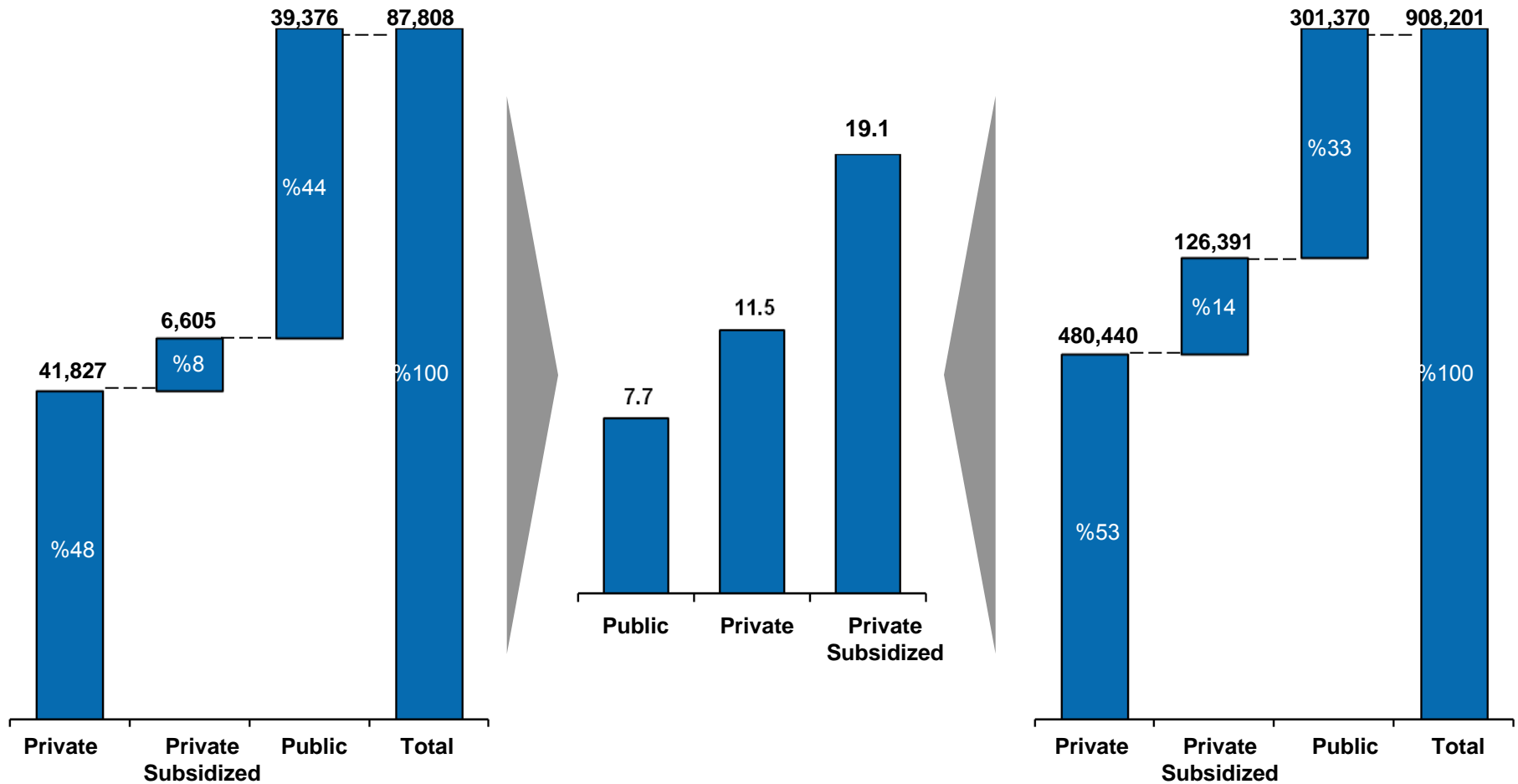


# Number of teachers and Students in General Education 2007-2008
