Key updates from Educational Institutions:

General Education & Center for Educational Research and Development (CERD)

The Directorate General of Education, in partnership with CERD, will launch a series of **digital learning webinars using Microsoft Teams** to public school teachers as of November 25, 2024. is scheduling digital learning training sessions

The 3G bundles of **20 GB per month** for every public-school student and teacher have now been distributed in partnership with the Ministry of Telecom.

Technical and Vocational Education

The Directorate General for Technical and Vocational Education is offering in person learning at 10 public technical and vocational education schools currently hosting displaced citizens. Technical and vocational education students at these schools are engaged in practical training.

Lebanese University

Remote learning (both synchronous and asynchronous – based on the needs of the students) continues across all faculties of the Lebanese University. Administrative presence is limited to Mondays and Tuesdays at the Lebanese University's centers, branches, and institutes in the administrative area of Beirut to complete urgent transactions while observing safety conditions.

Key Decisions & Milestones:

The Minister of Education and Higher Education, Dr. Abbas El-Halabi, **issued a letter to the educational community on the occasion of Flag Day and Independence Day 2024**. In the letter, he emphasized the importance of unity, resilience, and commitment to education in the face of ongoing aggression and tragedy in Lebanon. He also called on the educational community to support national unity, uphold the values of independence, and work together to rebuild and maintain the academic year despite the challenges.
